# **Bare Opera Privacy Policy**

Bare Opera, Inc. (the "Company," "we" or "our") is committed to protecting your privacy online. ## INFORMATION WE COLLECT WHEN YOU USE THE SITE

Information from Cookies and Similar Technologies. We and third-party partners collect information using cookies, pixels, and similar technologies. Our third-party partners, such as analytics partners, may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across different websites and online services. Cookies are small text files that contain a string of alphanumeric characters. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies. A

session cookie disappears after you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser and may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to our Site. We use the information we collect:

The use of your information following any of these events will be governed by the provisions of this Privacy Policy in effect at the time the applicable information was collected.
